Great Escapes From Buried Lies

Short Game Advisor

When faced with a badly buried lie in the sand, you have to adjust your expectations for the result of the shot. If you can get the ball on to the green with a chance to one-putt, that's a big win for any golfer. When you approach a buried lie, it is a hideous sight. The ball is plugged almost entirely below the surface and it's really easy to hit a low, ugly screamer over the green.

Since it's impossible to create a lot of backspin, most golfers think they can't get it close. Trust me, you can still save par. Toss out your negative thoughts and trust a new technique the next time you are faced with one of those "dead" lies in the bunker. The "Cock and Pop" is a shot I learned from my good friend and Champions Tour pro Tom Jenkins.

In the Cock and Pop method, you'll play the ball off your back foot and close the

clubface at address so the toe of the club will enter and dig into the sand first [photo 1]. When you take your backswing, you'll take the club back just a short distance, but you'll cock your wrists as much as possible before making your descending blow [photo 2].

Pop down onto the ball and don't make a significant "full" follow-through, as you would in a normal sand swing. Just pop down on it! [photo 3] The resistance of the sand will square the clubface as it flips the ball onto the green. Expect a lower trajectory than from a normal blast.

Try a few Cock and Pop shots from buried lies the next time you practice. Your shot pattern will be more spread out than normal, but trust the technique and you'll be surprised at how often you give yourself a chance of getting up and down when it looks impossible.



With all due respect to Rahm Emanuel, Michael Belot may just have been the busiest Chicagoan this summer. As Director of the 2012 Ryder Cup Matches, Belot has been in charge of planning and executing the world's biggest golf event. "It truly is," Belot acknowledged in a recent interview, "the Super Bowl of golf."

Come September 28, the efforts of the PGA, Medinah Country Club and throngs of volunteers will bear fruit following years of planning and enabling when the world's best players tee off to launch three days of intense competition. America's top 12 players will compete against Europe's premier dozen with each team determined to capture a trophy that has seemingly gained in luster each year since it was first unveiled in 1927 by British vegetable-seed merchant Samuel Ryder.

No matter the previous successes, endorsements and trophies won by each of the participants, even experienced pros acknowledge the personal significance of making the Ryder Cup team. "The Ryder Cup has been

the goal of every American player," asserted Hunter Mahan a few days after he learned that he didn't make this year's line-up.

Arnold Palmer, whose 23 lifetime points in Ryder Cup play is second only to Nick Faldo's 25 points, expressed in his memoirs why he thinks the event is so important. "It simply wasn't about playing for money. It was about playing for something far grander and more personal."

Tom Watson simply calls it "a big adventure" due to all of the variables involved in an 18-hole match between top-tier players. A single missed putt, an errant approach shot, or a poorly directed tee shot is oftentimes the difference between winning a match and losing it. While walking such a tightrope is tough enough when playing for hundreds of thousands in prize money, it becomes even tougher when competing on behalf of your peers and to represent your country. According to the players, these stakes magnify the Ryder Cup's intensity. Smooth swings all of a sudden lose their fluidity. Throats become drier. Hearts start pounding. And three-foot putts, usu-

ally treated like tap-ins by these guys, become wrenching exercises in self-discipline.

The specialness of the event promises to be compounded by the depth of talent on both sides. All 24 players on both teams rank among the top 36 in the world and 13 of them rank among the top 15 in the world. Team America is led by Tiger Woods, Phil Mickelson, and 2012 Masters Champion Bubba Watson. Team Europe is helmed by Rory McIlroy and Luke Donald—two of the top three players in the world. With Lee Westwood, whose world rank is #4, also on the team, it makes sense why many experts have made Europe favorites to retain the cup earned at Celtic Manor in Wales in 2010.

"They're going to be tough; they are every year," acknowledges U.S. team captain Davis Love III. "I'll tell you this: I love my team," he proclaims.

Dealt a seemingly perfect hand of a small field of outstanding players and a tournament-tested layout like Medinah's #3 course, one might be led to believe that the matches are a cinch to manage.

Champions Tour on its Way

Chicago's golf fans will get something to cheer for in 2013 as both the PGA Tour and Champions Tour return to the Chicago area.

The BMW Championship—being played at Crooked Stick in Carmel, Indiana, Sept. 3-9 this year—comes back to Illinois next fall to Conway Farms Golf Club in Lake Forest.

But the big news is the return of the Champions Tour, which will bring the Encompass Championship to North Shore Country Club in Glenview on June 17-23. Encompass Insurance is based in Northbrook.

The last time the men's senior circuit was in the area was in 2002 for the SBC Senior Open at Harborside International, marking an end to a seven-year run of tournaments.

North Shore CC most recently hosted the 2011 Western Amateur, breaking its long hiatus from tournament golf. The club hosted professionals at the 1933 U.S. Open and the 1928 Western Open.

Hole-in-One Contest At Ryder Cup Matches

Janis Joplin once asked for divine intervention so that she could acquire a Mercedes-Benz. All spectators at this year's Ryder Cup matches will have the opportunity to accomplish that same feat in one sweet swing. The luxury automobile manufacturer is hosting a hole-in-one contest on a 150-yard par 3 over water on Medinah's #1 Course throughout the event.

Every fan who rings up an ace will receive the keys to a 2013 GLK 350 with a limit of one auto per contestant. The hole is located just inside the country club's main gate. Each spectator can take one shot per day during gate hours. Even bad shots will be rewarded as each registrant receives a \$500 credit toward the purchase of a car.



Smith Captures U.S. Mid-Amateur Title at Conway Farms G.C.

Nathan Smith of Pittsburgh became the first four-time winner of the U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship by scoring a one-up victory over Garrett Rank of Canada in the event's 36-hole final conducted at Conway Farms Golf Club in Libertyville.

Smith, 34, became just the 15th person in USGA history to win the same championship at least four times. Others who have accomplished that feat include Jack Nicklaus, Mickey Wright, Carol Semple Thompson, and Bobby Jones.

The 2012 U.S. Mid-Amateur Championship, for players ages 25 and older, is one of 13 national championships conducted annually by the United States Golf Association, 10 of which are strictly for amateurs.

Both Smith and Rank earned exemptions to play in next year's U.S. Mid-Amateur in Alabama. Smith will also likely receive an invitation to the 2013 Masters Tournament, his fourth opportunity to play in one of golf's most prestigious tournaments.

Orrick Bests Malm, Small To Win State PGA Championship

Thirty-five-year-old Steve Orrick of Decatur Country Club fired a final round 65 to beat Chris Malm and Mike Small and capture the 90th Illinois PGA Championship. The victory was of historic proportions as no club professional from outside the Chicago area had won this tournament since 1952. Playing at Stonewall Orchard Golf Club in Grayslake, Orrick vaulted past 2012 PGA Match Play Championship winner Malm (who finished second) and 9-time Illinois PGA Championship winner Small (who finished fourth).

Orrick's 7-under-par final round score featured seven birdies and no bogies. Finishing third was David Paeglow of Kishwaukee C.C.

One of Chicagoans' favorite golf getaways celebrated its 25th anniversary in September. In total, the Mecca incorporates 17 golf courses, including layouts

"It has been an amazing journey," said Paul Beachnau, executive director of the Gaylord Area Chamber of Commerce. "We made it through some incredibly rough economic times that hit Midwesterners particularly hard. "But our group stuck together and continued

to make investments in the golf courses and in marketing them. The 2011 results speak for themselves." Indeed, the number of rounds played at Gaylord area golf courses increased by 13.5% last year with golf and accommodation sales combining for \$21.5 million in revenue.

Along with Treetops Resort, Gaylord Golf Mecca properties include Garland Resort, Otsego

Club, Marsh Ridge G.C., Black Forest G.C., Elk Ridge G.C., and Black Lake G.C. Exmoor's Blake Johnson (2010 Glenmorangie champion) and Kyle Nathan defeated the invitational's strongest field to date.

In addition to sponsoring the stellar play on the much-heralded Sugar Grove course, Glenmorangie donated \$1,000 to the First Tee Chapter of Fox Valley in Aurora.

Fazio Masterpiece Highlights Spectacular Grand Del Mar Resort

Nestled in San Diego's Los Penasquitos canyon, Grand Del Mar Resort is exquisite in every sense of the word. No less than *Condé Nast* magazine declared that this sprawling property just east of Interstate 5 is one of the "World's Best Places To Stay." All this praise is deserved, despite the fact that the resort opened a scant five years ago. Beautiful Mediterranean-themed architecture, marble floors, a 75-foot-long mosaic tile fountain, hand-crafted carpets, cathedral-sized ceilings, and thousands of newly planted trees are all touches that make this resort big, elegant and spectacular. Throw in the perfect So Cal weather and you can't help but wonder if you've stumbled upon a modern Eden.

Developed by Manchester Financial Group at a cost of \$270 million and 150,000 man-hours, the resort hotel piles on the guest amenities, including a 21,000 sq. ft. spa, four swimming pools, a fitness center, tennis courts, and an equestrian center. The centerpiece of the property is a Tom Fazio-designed championship course that stretches across 380 acres of the canyon preserve.

The 7,160-yard course is a wonderful test with spectacular views of the countryside as well as of the resort. It is truly a walk through nature. Scenic valleys give each hole a secluded feeling with very few holes adjacent to each other. While the landscape around you is dramatic, the course topography provides gentle rises and falls. Wide fairways greet your tee ball and tempt you to take some aggressive lines of play. Large, snaking white sand bunkers—a Fazio trademark—can be found across the entire layout.

The two best holes on the course are, not coincidentally, the two most dramatic holes. The 480-yard, fourth hole is listed as the most difficult hole on the course.




Florida's Sun Shines Brightly for Golfers

PGA NATIONAL RESORT
PGA National Resort & Spa is a celebration of golf. Located in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, this sprawling and splendid property is home to five championship courses. Home of the PGA Tour's Honda Classic, The Champion course was designed by Jack Nicklaus. Most Tour fans know The Champion course for its famed "Bear Trap" sequence—a three-hole stretch that perplexes and usually vexes golfers when played into a headwind. But PGA National is much more than 90 holes of magnificent golf. It is a full-service resort committed to serving up great experiences and great food.

The 2,340-acre vacation and meeting destination will complete a massive \$22 million improvements project in October. One can easily get lost on the property for a week by sampling all the fabulous amenities, including spa services, swimming pools, racquet sports, and multiple dining options. Although the resort was a beehive of activity during our visit, expect personalized services from both the resort and golf staffs.

The property's name seems to ensure that its focus will always be on our favorite pastime. The five courses were designed by a virtual all-star cast of great architects led by Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, and Tom & George Fazio. Amazingly, each course is distinct from its counterparts. The Palmer has a Scottish feel. The Haig—a tribute to tour legend Walter Hagen—allows players provides generous landing areas and multiple approach shot options. The Squire, named after the amazing Gene Sarazen, offers a test of shot-making and creativity. Even though my favorite was The Champion, it was less because of the course's reputation for testing the world's greatest players and more because of the surprising changes



COAST TO COAST

But don't be intimidated by the length, as the blue tees reduce this par 4 to a far more playable 412 yards. The tee is perched high above the canyon floor, thus providing both amazing scenery as well as a great launching pad for a descending drive that gains extra carry. While the tee shot landing area is generous, it sets up a difficult long-iron or wood to a narrow sloping green.

The 416-yard, fifteenth hole is almost a bookend to the aforementioned fourth hole. The tee is located on the highest point of the golf course, providing still another breathtaking panorama. A forced-carry over brush is required to reach another generous landing area. Don't be fooled by the open view to the green from here as the fairway dips to the left of the green to capture and collect all approach shots in that direction. A sand bunker to that side only adds to the difficulty.

The 363-yard length on hole 18 seems to indicate a cupcake finish to the course. Nothing could be further from the truth, as bunkers protect the tee shot landing area. Closer to the green, a creek bisects the fairway while deep sand bunkers lie in waiting to the left of the putting surface. Tightening the approach further is a large, beautiful waterfall that protects the right side.

The resort's golf staff, headed by Shawn Cox, Director of Golf, offers private and group lessons to sharpen your game. In addition to the on-site staff, Dave Pelz holds his Scoring Game School on the grounds. Dave Stockton, Jr. of Dave Stockton Golf Academy has recently joined the staff to help hone your short game.

As with every aspect of Grand del Mar, dining at the resort is unrivaled. Addison is the hotel's signature restaurant and is a must for those seeking pampering. The establishment's wine collection spans over 3,600 selections. The plating presentation by the staff was perfectly timed during my visit and each course featured an amazing wine pairing.

Accommodations at the resort cross the spectrum from great to spectacularly decadent. The hotel's new "Coast to Canyon" golf package kicks off this fall and includes overnight accommodations at The Grand, a round on the legendary

of topography over the flat south Florida landscape.

The Champion was originally designed by the aforementioned Fazio brothers and was redesigned in 1991 by Nicklaus. Its modest length (for a tournament course) of 7,048 yards is less relevant than some imposing statistics: 107 bunkers and 16 out of the 18 holes featuring water hazards. That said, don't expect to reduce your handicap by attacking the flagstick.

Don't fret if you leave any of the courses with aches and pains. The 40,000 sq. ft. Spa at PGA National offers sports massages along with a wide array of services provided in 32 treatment rooms. Those looking to soothe their minds and bodies head for the facility's "Waters of the World" where one can bathe in the pristine waters of Salies de Bearn from the Pyrenees Mountains.

Now thoroughly rejuvenated and relaxed, head to the property's 33,000-sq.-ft. fitness center or play tennis on one of 19 Har-Tru tennis courts. Other offerings include racquetball, jogging paths, fitness classes, a lap pool and five tournament-certified croquet lawns.

Dining options include the Ironwood Steak & Seafood Restaurant featuring Waygu and Black Angus beef dry-aged for 21 days and cooked to perfection at 1200 degrees. Other dining and drinking options include the Monte Cristo Lounge, the Waters of the World Café, and the iBar.

Information on fall packages for PGA National Resort can be found at www.pgaresort.com. From October 16 to January 12, the resort is running a fall golf package that includes lodging, unlimited golf [surcharge for The Champion], 50% off the Leadbetter Golf Academy Daily Clinic, and breakfast for \$199 per day.

BOCA RATON RESORT & CLUB Built in the 1920s, this Waldorf Astoria property is synonymous with elegance and luxury. You can't drive anywhere in this community of the rich and famous and not notice the tall pink sprawling Mediterranean-style resort facility designed by legendary architect Addison Mizner.

The centerpieces of the 356-acre oceanside complex are two





championship courses: the Resort Course and the Country Club Course. The Boca Resort has a rich tradition and history and claims former PGA Tour stars Sam Snead and Tommy Armour as past PGA professional staff members. Many guests book rooms specifically to receive lessons at the renowned Dave Pelz Scoring Game School

The Resort Course is one of the most enjoyable resort courses that we've had the privilege to play. Conditioning from tee to green is impeccable. The 6,253-yard layout is built for fun and optimal scoring. Fairways are shaped to allow golfers of all abilities to have a good time. Mounds gently re-direct balls down to the fairway. Though not long by today's standards, the course's many doglegs do not allow for bomb-and-gouge play. Water tightens 13 holes and gives an advantage to shotmakers.

The Country Club Course stretches to 6,714 yards. The tract's signature hole is the eighteenth, home to an island green with well-placed bunkers and a multi-tiered green.

The patio of 501 East—a casual dining option on site—offers great viewing of the action commencing on the 18th green. Along with golf, the resort provides a luxury spa, a marina, a fitness center, tennis courts, and seven swimming pools. The Tower Pool features 12 cabanas each with a personal butler.

The newly renovated Boca Beach Club offers hundreds of elegantly appointed accommodations including rooms with stunning views of the ocean and the Intercoastal Waterway.

4 HOLES

That Will Determine the 2012 Ryder Cup Champion

Match play, according to two-time Ryder Cup team member Johnny Miller, "exposes your character and how much of a will to win you have in your heart."

That said, character and heart will be on full display across Medinah Country Club's #3 Course come September 28th – 30th when 24 of the world's best players battle each other in the 39th Ryder Cup Matches. Led by three of the top four players in the world rankings, Team Europe is considered a slight favorite to retain the cup earned in 2010 at Celtic Manor Resort in Wales. Given home field advantage and a strong team anchored by Tour veterans Tiger Woods, Steve Stricker, and Jim Furyk, Team USA is expected to put up an excellent fight. Don't count them out.

The team match play format that makes this event distinct from every other event on the PGA Tour tends to place emphasis on a small number of holes that can change the context of a match. These holes are either long and susceptible to bogeys or short and amenable to birdies. If you are one of the lucky few to have secured tickets to attend the matches, you may wish to arrive early to receive a good vantage point on one of these four holes. According to a number of experts, there is a reasonable likelihood that one or all of these will determine which team is spraying itself with champagne on Sunday evening.

On a course that stretches to 7,658 yards, easy-birdie holes are few and far between. Even the shortest par 3 on the course, No. 2, plays to a grueling 192 yards. With two of Medinah's par 5s set up at over 600 yards, only two others can be considered modest by today's high-tech standards.

Gary D'Amato, prize-winning golf writer of *The Milwaukee Journal*, plans to keep an eye on one par 5 in particular: "No. 5 could be a pivotal hole early in matches, many of which could be all square going into the shortest par 5 on the course. The green is reachable in two after a good drive and invites a risk/reward approach into the elevated putting surface. The gallery's roar after an eagle by Team USA would reverberate through the fairway-interrupted forest that is Medinah. Conversely, an eagle by the Europeans would put a screeching halt to early U.S. momentum. In any case, expect to see some fireworks on No. 5. Even in the alternate shot format, par probably won't win the hole and likely will lose it."

Michael Nolan, Tournament Director of the 2012 Matches, echoes D'Amato's opinion. "Players will be expected to make birdie on No. 5. It's a true risk/reward hole. I think you'll see lots of scoreboard shifting after each group walks off that green. There will be more wins and losses on this hole and not a lot of pushes."

If that Mayhem guy from the insurance commercials were to sponsor a hole at Medinah during Ryder Cup week, this "short" par 4 would undoubtedly be the one he'd select. While listed on the scorecard at 391 yards, No. 15 will definitely be adjusted in the course set-up to give players a chance to reach this green off the tee.

Master architect Rees Jones was brought back to Medinah following his 2003 re-work of the Tom Bendelow-designed course specifically to adjust greens and to make No. 15 a dramatic match-play hole. Players seeking to win a hole down the stretch will reach into their bags for the long stick and ignore the sand bunkers in front of this green and the collection area behind it.

"There's not another hole on the course like No. 15," says Nolan. "It's going to be absolutely exciting to observe how players approach this hole. The members love this hole because it's fun and playable. I think the Ryder Cup players will enjoy how No. 15 allows for different strategies depending on wind conditions and hole setup."

The 1999 PGA Championship is remembered by many golf fans for the approach shot struck by a young Sergio Garcia on this par 4. The Spaniard had hit his tee shot dead next to a large oak nearly 200 yards from the green. He proceeded to hit his 6-iron second shot on the green with his eyes closed. The miraculous approach kept him in contention for the title eventually won by Tiger Woods.

Mike Munro, owner of White Pines Golf Dome in Bensenville, says he will be keeping an eye on No. 16 throughout each day's matches. "Many members consider this to be the hardest par 4 on the course. It measures 452 yards and plays every bit of it due to its significant elevation change from the tee to the green. The hole is a big dogleg left and requires a high and long tee shot to clear many large trees located on the left side of the fairway. Longer hitters, especially those that hit it from right to left, will look at this hole with excitement, while the shorter hitters may struggle to make par. As if the tee shot isn't hard enough, the second shot must land on a severely elevated green which makes stopping the ball extremely difficult. Only the top of the flagstick is viewable from the fairway. Balls that come up short of the green pose the possibility of rolling back nearly 100 feet. Most golfers will likely make bogey if they end up in this precarious position at the base of the green. Shots hit long in the tall rough will have difficulty in getting up and down due to the back to front contoured green.

"Don't be surprised," Munro continues, "if the PGA puts the pin in the back right quadrant on Sunday which will put the deep bunker directly in front of it very much in play. From there, a skillful sand shot is needed to get the ball up and over the deep lip of the bunker and make it stop in the narrow crook of the green. The 16th hole has been a pivotal hole for many other Ryder Cups played at other great courses. It promises to be again this year."



Anyone who has played Medinah #3 over the years knows No. 17 to be the course's signature par 3. With a tee perched high above the green fronted by water and supported by a huge sand bunker, the hole is as beautiful as it is dangerous. According to Michael J. Scully, Director of Golf at Medinah, look to this hole for chills, spills, birdies, and bogies. "The key here will be the wind off Lake Kadajah," he says, adding, "and the nerves of trying to win a match to win the 39th Ryder Cup. Hitting this relatively flat green will be the key with being long or left, making up and down quite difficult."

In previous championships held at Medinah, including the 1990 U.S. Open won by Hale Irwin and the 2006 PGA Championship won by Woods, the pin position on No. 17 played a significant role in how the competitors challenged the hole. Even when the flagstick is tucked near the front of this green, players attempt to steer tee shots just over the lake so as to leave an uphill birdie putt.

But it's not as easy as it sounds. Thousands of details are involved in planning the event, from player meetings to golf course conditioning to a reception at the Akoo Theatre in Rosemont for volunteer management. "It's all a fun challenge," Belot said. "But the challenge isn't in managing the details we know; rather, it is in preparing for the unexpected—things like bad weather and how that could affect traffic and parking and the television schedule.

"What makes this event different from other events," Belot said, "is the international aspect. There's the gala to schedule and then there's opening ceremonies—and then, by the way, you do play golf!"

The role requires Belot, who lives in Wheaton with wife Katie and two sons, to wear many hats from managing ticket sales to marketing and public relations efforts to parking and traffic management. "We have over 800 acres of property to work with at Medinah," he said. "And yet there is no dead or unused space anywhere."

Everyone in attendance over the three days of the event, Belot said, will feel the electric atmosphere that the Ryder Cup generates. "There's a feeling on site that can't be described," he said. "The roars heard during these matches are unlike the roars you hear at other tournaments, even the majors," he added. "That's the fun of being there."

Playing conditions at Medinah are expected to be superb. Rees Jones was brought to the course in 2009 to recontour and rebuild 11 greens in a \$1.5 million renovation. "Rees did an excellent job of making the course both playable for the members and yet challenging for the world's best players," Belot said. While the PGA provided input, opinions and thoughts on renovations made to the course prior to the matches, club members oversaw all stages of the process.

The most significant change made on the course in this renovation was that a new short par 4 was created to create a classic risk-reward challenge that will encourage players to try to reach this green off the tee. According to Jones, the new 15th "comes at a crucial point in the round, following the long par-5 14th and before the famous closing three-hole stretch," he said. "The landing area and the green have shifted slightly up the slope to the left, while the new two-acre pond protects the entire right side of the hole."

"We can't wait for people to come out and experience the Ryder Cup," Belot stated. "I believe," he added, "that it's going to be absolutely exciting."





Pretty Little Poppy

After a legendary career of over 45 years toiling in the vineyards of Sonoma County, Richard Arrowood opened his latest (and perhaps final) winery, Amapola Creek, in 2005. Amapola is Spanish for "poppy," and the creek that bears the name runs through the estate. When in bloom, the golden poppies line the creek and offer a lovely sight with the vineyards and mountains in the background.

The 100-acre ranch (purchased in 2001) that is home to Amapola Creek is situated on the western slope of the Mayacamas Mountains, which rise between and separate the Sonoma and Napa valleys. Although his wife Alis envisioned the site as the perfect place for a peaceful retirement, Richard had other ideas, and immediately set about selecting the best 20 acres of the property for use as the centerpiece of Amapola Creek Winery.

The mountainside estate vineyards are footed in red-brown volcanic soils, and are California Certified Organic. The winery itself is an "organic handling facility," reflecting the Arrowoods' commitment to making wine in the most natural way possible, as well as their "prevention not intervention" philosophy. The solar-powered winery is a small-production, ultra-premium facility with state-of-the-art equipment. To preserve quality, total annual production is just 3,000 cases.

2010 Chardonnay, Russian River Valley \$45
The Rued and Dijon Chardonnay clones that make up this wine were grown by a single farmer, Joseph Belli, a long-time friend and associate of Arrowood's. The harvest was aged for 10 months in new and old French oak, under malolactic fermentation, and yielded a mere 210 cases.

The nose features aromas of stone fruits such as nectarine and peach, with a hint of flint. Those flavors continue on the palate, along with highly-integrated oak and structural acidity. It's all wrapped up with an unctuous mouthfeel and long finish. Drink this unfined wine now, or hold for up to 10 years.

2008 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon \$60
The fruit for this wine came from the high elevation Arrowood estate acreage, which

features the aforementioned mineral-rich basaltic volcanic soils, and cooling breezes from San Pablo Bay.

This is the fourth Cabernet released by Amapola. The wine was aged for 24 months in new and seasoned French and American oak. This elegant wine shows excellent harmony and structure. The nose opens with cherries, black fruits, and cassis, plus a suggestion of cedar. The taste features effusive blackberry, plum, and currant. The fruit is offset by a pleasing dustiness, and is accompanied by a mouthfeel of firm acidity over fine tannins. A delicate hint of toasty oak and vanilla displays the true varietal nature of Cabernet Sauvignon. Consider buying a case, and enjoying a bottle for the next twelve years.

Clash of the Titans

Four years ago this past August, I was a part of a roundtable discussion (along with *GOLFChicago* publisher Dave Weretka) talking about the United States' chances in the Ryder Cup at Valhalla Golf Club in Louisville, Kentucky.

I remember, clearly, doubting that the Americans would win on home soil, due in large part to the absence of Tiger Woods and the presence of three automatic-qualifying rookies and three additional rookie captain's picks.

I remember clearly, because the United States won 16½ to 11½ to break a three-tournament winning streak by the Europeans.

That victory, along with a narrow, one-point loss at the Celtic Manor resort in Wales in 2010, has me thinking the United States will win its second Ryder Cup this millennium at Medinah Country Club September 28-30.

Like in 2008, three rookies have automatically qualified: Jason Dufner, Keegan Bradley, and Webb Simpson, and another was selected by way of a captain's pick in Brandt Snedeker. Like 2008, Steve Stricker was a captain's pick as well.

The team was rounded out by captain Davis Love III with veteran Jim Furyk and Dustin Johnson as his other two picks.

"I think we have got a great team," Love III said. "I think we are extremely deep this time; I think deeper than we have ever been."

Four years ago, you had Anthony Kim, Ben Curtis, and Boo Weekley playing their way in. This year, you have Dufner, who is No. 7 in the world (as of September 4th) and has two wins, three runner-ups, and an additional 11 top ten's since the beginning of 2011, as well as two recent Major champions: Bradley and Simpson.

Toss in a motivated Woods and fellow major champions Bubba Watson, Zach Johnson, and Phil Mickelson along with Players champ Matt Kuchar, and the U.S. team seems loaded for bear.

"[The] Ryder Cup means everything," said Bradley, who watched the U.S. win at The Country Club in Brookline, Massachusetts, in 1999. "It's going to be a real challenge for me that week to stay calm and not get too excited. It's a great event. I can't wait to play."

"I think we've got one of the best teams in a while. I think a lot of really good guys, we're all very close. I think it's going to be a good match."

"In the past, I was leery of teams heavy on rookies, mostly because of the abnormal pressure the Ryder Cup creates."

"You know, you're not just playing for yourself," newly minted PGA Champion and European team member Rory McIlroy said. "You're playing for your teammates. You're playing for your country. And that brings a whole different type of pressure."

Yet in the last two Cups, the rookies who played their way into automatic spots proved they belonged, and recent U.S. captains Paul Azinger and Corey Pavin have struck gold with their rookie picks.

"It's such a huge opportunity for me to be in my first Ryder Cup and look forward to getting to Medinah and making Davis look like he's a genius and play as good as I possibly can," Snedeker said.

Two of the U.S. rookies—Bradley and Dufner—have admitted they have never seen Medinah Country Club and had planned to get in a few practice rounds before the end of the month, which will be necessary considering the European team includes World No. 1 McIlroy, No. 2 Luke Donald, No. 4 Lee Westwood, and No. 9 Justin Rose.

Graeme McDowell, Sergio Garcia, and Francesco Molinari are also in the top 25.

"The European Team is obviously great," Love III said. "They are playing well. [Captain] José Maria [Olazabal], like me, had a tough choice and he did a great job. You know, I know they are going to be tough; they are every year. But I can tell you this: I love my team. I'm excited about my team, and I can't wait to see how it matches up."

Europe, once again, is formidable, but this is one of the few years in recent history where the Americans can feel like the favorite going into a Ryder Cup. The team has 15 wins and three majors this year. Toss in a sold-out gallery in a golf-starved, sports-crazed market like Chicago and the U.S. team has a distinct advantage.

"Any time you can put the stars and stripes on your sleeve and play some golf ... this is the closest I'll get to the military, so for me it's about representing our country and playing some golf and hopefully win it," Watson said. "But all in all, just like the athletes in the Olympics, all you're trying to do is represent your country well and show people some exciting golf."
