The Rabito Foundation: An Opportunity for Excellence

Securing a full ride to play golf in college is a long journey that involves junior golf tournaments, traveling to marguee events, and making contacts with the right people. It is also an expensive journey. Unlike other high school sports where the elite players are showcased at high school games and meets on the court, field, or pitch, golf's elite players earn their mettle in junior events that send them across the country to play against the best of the best. For most families, to go all in and position their children for a full scholarship is a bit of a dice game, and the stakes can be a huge fiscal burden.

For 25 years, Carl Rabito has worked with the world's best players from the major professional tours around the world. From his work with college players to the LPGA and PGA Tours, Rabito, and his golf schools, have produced champions. Rabito understands that most families are not in a position to toss their savings into a child's golf swing. "Golf is expensive. I see parents make it happen with great sacrifice. The scaffolding begins with an intensive program that involves swing analysis, on-course training, and a guided instructional program. Rabito shares, "We are going to award a golf education worth thousands of dollars. This is big stuff." Amazingly, the Foundation's program requires just sweat equity from the selected candidates, not a financial planner to reshuffle the family's savings. Candidates who are selected will enter the program ready to begin an education with concrete goals, rigorous instruction and a practice curriculum.

The Rabito Foundation is hoping to provide the resources and skill sets that will lead to a champion. The merit-based program is seeking players in grades seven to ten who are ready to commit to an intensive program. The tryouts will determine the best candidates for the program. The ultimate goal for the foundation and Rabito is to build a highly skilled player, instill ethical conduct, and promote good citizenship. Rabito adds, "We are not just building a golfer. We are building a better person who represents their community and golf in the highest regard." While the outcomes are a few years away, the Rabito Foundation is paving a new path for young golfers and their families that could fulfil the dream of a kid searching for a way to golf at the next level.

Working for Next Year

THE FITNESS EDGE


We are entering fall in Chicago and, unfortunately, once again our baseball teams are looking forward to next year. Just like the Cubs and Sox, since there are plenty of beautiful weekends before winter season, it is a good time to start training for a better game next year.

A golf swing requires balance, timing, flexibility, strength, and a comprehensive program that will improve your swing in addition to your overall fitness. The old perception that Pilates and yoga are for wiry, overly flexible people does not hold true anymore. Yoga and Pilates have been integrated into training regiments for toplevel athletes and can be adjusted to meet the needs of most golfers.

Varieties of yoga range from mildly strenuous to highly intense exercise. There are considerations for which is best for your overall health, fitness level, and if relaxation/ meditation is a need. Vinyasa (flow) yoga and Ashtanga (power) yoga are two types that will give an intense workout that removes any preconceived ideas that yoga is not a workout. If you are looking for less intense exercise, or are a beginner, consider Hatha yoga or a restorative yoga. Regardless of intensity, all forms of yoga will improve overall strength and flexibility in addition to increased balance and focus. For the golfer who needs to improve shoulder, trunk, and hip flexibility, yoga will give you a greater range of motion along with better body control. The added consistency in your swing, along with the flexibility and strength, will add distance and accuracy to your shots. If you happen to be a golfer that stresses out over those pesky four-foot putts, then the mind-body integration qualities of yoga could save you a few strokes and headaches each round.

Pilates has been around since the early 1900s with an early concentration on training and rehabilitating dancers. Pilates has become a popular fitness method because it addresses flexibility and core stabilization. There are several variations that range in intensity level, but most Pilates programs are similar and will make you work. Pilates places a strong emphasis on strengthening and stabilizing the core muscles along with promoting proper posture. The emphasis on posture will translate to a solid back position during your swing. By generating more power through the core and by increasing rotation through the trunk and hips, you will be able to move your hips and legs through the ball more efficiently. Improved accuracy and increased distance are also a nice reward.

Driving distance and accuracy are great reasons to add either of these programs to your exercise routine. But there are other benefits that include decreasing your risk of injury by improving muscle balance, improving your endurance to produce quality shots for 18 holes, and prolonging the years you can play at a high level. When you employ these exercises into your workout routine, you will look much better on the course with a slimmer waistline and toned muscle. Another side effect of Pilates and yoga is you'll need to save some cash this off-season. After just a few months of exercise, you will need to buy shorts and shirts that fit your new physique next vear.

Soirée in the Sandhills

OFF THE BEATEN CART PATH

A new golf course opening in the United States is a big deal these days. When it is a Tom Doak-designed course in the now legendary Sand Hills of Western Nebraska, it is huge. When it is at the utterly unique Dismal River Club, already home to an iconoclastic Jack Nicklaus-designed course, it becomes epic.

Club CEO and part owner Chris Johnston—a dead ringer for comedian Ron White in looks and demeanor—said he wanted a companion course to help draw more visitors and members to this remote outpost. He nailed it with the Doak addition.

Sitting on 3,000 acres of windswept high prairie land in Hooker County (pop 1,000) near the town of Mullen (population 351) at the end of a 20-mile single lane road, you don't so much visit Dismal River as make a pilgrimage. "It's a dude ranch for golf," Johnston proudly announces.

After contacting several architects in 2010 about the proposed course (including Tiger Woods) Johnston and Doak came to an agreement."Mr. Doak doesn't just take any course," he said. "You don't 'pick' him. He 'picks' you." "I always want to do something different than I've done before, and something different than the neighbors," Doak said when asked about being compared to the existing Nicklaus course. "We've worked next to several of the best courses in the world before —Pacific Dunes was next to Bandon Dunes; Sebonack was next to Shinnecock Hills and The National, and The Renaissance Club is next to Muirfield in Scotland. You're unlikely to "beat" those neighbors in the rankings, so you're better off just trying to build a course that's different and has a character of its own, and see what people think."

Once on the job, Doak had to focus on a routing plan. "I knew I would want to gravitate down toward the river. It's a unique feature that none of the other courses in the region have available, both the river and then the giant bluff on the opposite bank. It helps orient the golfer, whereas on other courses in the area, you sometimes just feel lost among all the dunes."

Speaking of orienting among the dunes, there is a common perception, or perhaps misconception, that the challenge in designing a sand hills course isn't finding holes so much as eliminating many of the possibilities. It isn't quite that easy. "Everyone says you could find 1,000 different holes in the sand hills, but the truth is that most of them would feature blind shots, and a lot of them would run into a dead end where there wasn't another good hole to follow them," said Doak. "Trying to string a bunch of great holes together is a bit more difficult than we make it look, when we succeed."

Once the routing had been settled, there was often very little earth moving to be done because the terrain and soil profile is just vegetated dunes covering an ocean of fine sand. No drain pipe was needed anywhere. Bunkers weren't constructed in the conventional sense, they were just dug out wherever needed and left to weather.

"Some of the greens were just laying there; there were several of them that took less than one hour to shape!" Doak exclaimed. The entire course from soup to nuts came in under \$2 million, which is practically unheard of today, especially with a marquee architect.

If the construction of the Doak course at Dismal River was a bargain, then Wild Horse Golf Club in Gothenburg was an outright steal at under a million dollars.

Conceived by a couple of local farmers who were frustrated that their nine-hole muni kept flooding every time it rained, Wild Horse had no business succeeding—the farmers called it the Cart Before the Horse course—but through the efforts of the local community and a pair of golf course construction veterans, it has.

Dave Axland and Dan Proctor, who had been building courses with Ben Crenshaw and Bill Coore for years, found out about the Wild Horse project just as they were finishing up at the venerable Sand Hills Golf Club in Mullen, and convinced the farmers to let them design and build their golf course. That was a fortuitous decision.

Without any mapping or topographical data they went about building Wild Horse by eye and on foot. Area farmers became so fascinated by what they were seeing they would stop by every morning with their equipment to bust up the sod and do what little shaping was necessary.

The result at Wild Horse is a stunning combination of generous fairways framed

by prairie grasses on rolling dunes, greens open to run up shots, and dramatic blowout bunkers galore.

Clearly the most complete golf experience in the Nebraska Sand Hills is at The Prairie Club in Valentine, just south of the South Dakota border.

Founder Paul Schock states the mission, "I do not like the fact that avid golfers can't get on great golf courses, so I want this place to be a club where there will always be a place for somebody who can't afford to be a member... we need more of the truly great golf available to more people. That's a key part of our vision and always will be."

Featuring the Tom Lehman designed Dunes course, the Graham Marsh designed Pines course, and a 10-hole par 3 layout by Gil Hanse, the Prairie Club offers lodging in the 31 clubhouse rooms plus four cabins along the Snake River Canyon. Fine dining is available in the Canyon Room with additional seating in the casual bar area.

The golf is stupendous at the Prairie Club. The Dunes is a monstrous golf course with 80-yard-wide fairways, bunkers that







could hide a small army and an array of uphill and downhill shots that make yardage calculations a faint guess. The Pines is a bit more traditional in scale and plays into the adjoining pine forest to the edge of the Snake River. The two complement each other perfectly. The Hanse course is just a sweet little walk in the park.

If you're a golfer looking to play courses similar to those in the motherland of Scotland without the time, expense, and hassle of international travel, then the Sand Hills of Western Nebraska is your next best bet.

Stick Your Finish

t's common to hear a television golf commentator praise a tour player for having great flexibility when they finish their swing with their shoulders and hips facing left of the target. This leads people to believe the more you turn the better you are. The player may possess great flexibility, but it does not mean it's the best place to finish a golf swing.

There needs to be an end point to the golf swing—a very specific ending point to the swing. The proper end or finish point | the golf ball. to a golf swing should be the one in which the player's chest, hips, and thighs all face exactly at the target. If your shoulders are overturned at the finish of the swing, it is an indication that the shoulders and hips are out of sequence. When the shoulders have overturned it typically means the hips have "out raced" or moved too soon, ahead of the shoulders. This is a major catalyst for slicing

The idea is to have the hips, shoulders, arms, hands, and club finish the swing at the same time. A proper swing does not end when your body can't move anymore; it ends when your body is facing the target. Imagine a gymnast's dismount; there is a precise end point to the routine.

y trip to the Auld Sod in July included golf at some of the great courses across the northern part of the country, along with spectatorship at the Aberdeen Asset Management Scottish Open—one of the game's great spectacles. In between those events, I visited a few castles, took a tour of the Glenmorangie distillery in Tain and made the acquaintance of a handful of new friends. While golf is a year 'round sport here, the season is classically defined as starting in April and stretching through September. Summertime offers many positives, beginning with temperate weather. Tee times on the great links courses that dot the country—starting with the Old Course at St. Andrews—are at a premium during this time frame. Perhaps the best justification for booking one's trip between June and July is the impossibly long days with the sun rising just past 4 a.m. and setting at around 10 p.m. The obvious implications on the number of rounds one can play during a full day tantalize the mind and stimulate the soul.

While the distance between the Edinburgh and the Highlands may seem imposing on the map, the fact is that it's just under a three-hour ride across a stunning landscape that makes the drive seem even shorter.

Here is a recap of my journey's highlights:

The Nairn Golf Club

Heralded by many national golf publications as one of Scotland's top 10 courses, Nairn was built in 1887. Over the years, this links has hosted the British Amateur and, most recently, both the 1999 Walker Cup matches and the 2012 Curtis Cup. The links was built over a highland wilderness of gorse and heather, and features spectacular views of the Moray Firth on every hole.

The first seven holes play along the coastline and crisscross up gentle rises surrounded by heavy rough. "Nae wind, nae rain, nae golf," goes

Simply put, all avid golfers—regardless of age, handicap, or geography—must eventually find their way to Scotland, the Home of Golf. The lure of this ancient land is unmistakable yet difficult to define. Perhaps it is the rolling rural landscape that draws us. Or perhaps it is the spray of the waves churning in from the sea. Or perhaps it is the hospitality of the Scots, many of whom can trace their roots back for centuries. Probably, it's all of the above. Whatever the reason, or reasons, for touring this great country, everyone who visits inevitably comes home with a lifetime of anecdotes. stories, and amazing experiences.

the Scottish aphorism. While the fair weather during my trip eliminated one of the variables, I must admit that the delightful breezes during my round at Nairn made the first seven holes much easier to navigate than I expected. Hard and fast is the mantra here, which makes tee shots bound a few extra yards, but it also means that approach shots need to be calculated for the additional roll.

The putting surfaces across the property are immaculate. The fairways offer humps and hollows and thus make even lies about as easy to find as lawyers who undercharge for their services. Hole #3 is a testy dogleg left that tempts players to carry a corner that is devilishly guarded by three bunkers. Hole #4 is a short par 3 that heads toward the sea wall. Featuring a bowl-shaped green, this may be one's best chance at birdie on the course.

The championship course's finishing hole, appropriately nicknamed "Home," is a long but accommodating par 5 as it tends to play downwind. Avoid the thick rough that lines the left side of the fairway to set-up a short-iron approach to a putting surface guarded by sand bunkers on both sides. There's no better feeling in the world than making birdie on the final hole of a great links course!

The Golf View Hotel and Spa is just a short walk from Nairn's first tee. The hotel serves up 42 rooms—most facing the sea—and provides a comfortable environment to unwind and recount your strokes. A pool, spa, fine dining, and other amenities are also available.

Castle Stuart


Page through the property's strokesaver book and savor the quote: "Castle Stuart itself reflects an appreciation that the game of golf is more about error and recovery than it is about perfection. Its ethos is more about redemption than it is about punishment." How, possibly, could the general manager of this great golf course have written this before











observing me take one mighty whack with the big stick? The Great Kreskin would've been proud!

Castle Stuart was home to the Aberdeen Asset Management Scottish Open the past few seasons, including the event that concluded in July with a resoundingly popular victory by adopted Scotsman Phil Mickelson. You'll remember that Lefty followed up that national championship with an Open Championship victory a week later. The 2014 Aberdeen Asset Management Scottish Open will be contested at Royal Aberdeen in Aberdeen on July 10-13, 2014.

The fairways of Castle Stuart are wide and receptive. Or, at least they seem so off the tee until one observes a driver take a wild bounce into the gorse adjacent to the second cut of rough. Views of the sea and several landmarks of the Highlands are omnipresent. These include the Kessock Bridge and the Chanonry Lighthouse. The ruggedly natural setting offers 18 individual, secluded links holes. The wispy fescue that lines several holes reminds one of gentler times when competitors in Open Championships stood a fairly good chance of recovering from an errant tee shot with a full shot to the green. Recovery out of this rough is feasible so long as one navigates the sand bunkers that oftentimes stand guard beside the putting surfaces. Says Mark Parsinen, the club's managing partner, "No map is necessary; just a good eye and ability to look, listen and choose." If time provides the opportunity, visitors to Castle Stuart should seek out multiple opportunities to play this wondrous and challenging links track.

Royal Dornoch

Not too many decades ago, this 18-hole championship course in the charming town of Dornoch was known only to a savvy few. The rise of Royal Dornoch in world course rankings is relatively recent, as it was designed way back in 1886 by Old Tom Morris, and managed by course professional





The Carnegie Club Links at Skibo Castle




(and legendary architect) Donald Ross. Yet, due to its remote location-and difficult access because of limited roads to the area-it did not receive its due recognition until the 1970s when Tom Watson and Ben Crenshaw sung its praises.


While the scenery, including wondrous views of Dornoch Bay, may distract one into playing above his or her handicap level, the crowned greens that define the course are as devious as they are intriguing. Even a slightly errant approach to the putting surface virtually ensures an awkward chip shot to the flagstick.

Royal Dornoch has not been part of the Open rotation solely due to its remote location and limited infrastructure to hold events of that magnitude. That said, the course has played host to British Amateur championships. A true links, it starts innocently enough with a short par 4 and quickly turns up the pressure with a 167-yard hole that honorary member Watson has called the most difficult par 3 he's encountered due to the crowned green that accepts only the truest of tee shots. Anything less either finds deep sand bunkers or veers off the putting surface. The third hole is the gateway to the most beautiful stretch of holes in the world as each plays alongside the bay. Magnificent contours, sweeping dunes, huge deep bunkers, and gorse bushes all add to both the scenery and the difficulty.

No review of Royal Dornoch can ignore the signature hole No. 14 nicknamed "Foxy" on the scorecard. Described by Harry Vardon as "the most natural hole in golf," this 440vard par 4 features wild dunes that protect the left side of the fairway and a series of hillocks that protect the right side. While no man-made hazards defend the hole, its narrow raised green makes the long-iron or wood approach shot extremely difficult to negotiate. A par here makes one's round a rousing success.







Hot and Spicy: Golf to Dye For in Cancun

ver the course of 18 seasons, Golf Channel Ohas seen The Big Break become a fixture in its weekly lineup. The program's tremendous amount of success has given producers a reason to be picky as to where their next installment will take place and what course will play host. So when it was determined that season 19, which has aired throughout the summer, would take place at Mexico's Iberostar Playa Paraiso Golf Club, there was solid justification for the show to be heading south of the border.

Located in Riviera Maya, the Playa Paraiso course is everything you want in vacation golf, and a whole lot more. Designed by P.B. Dye (Legends Club, Fisher Island) this track is set in the middle of the jungle and gives you plenty of playable options, but you'll need a machete if you choose to overlook those options.

A par 72 weighing in at 6,897-yards, it feels like every bit of a heavy weight at the end of the day. It would be an understatement to say that straight shots are rewarded on this course. The middle of the fairway is your very best friend as Dye has done an outstanding job at bringing in the jungle ever so tightly, especially on the par 4s. It's quite obvious why this course also plays host to the Monday qualifier for the PGA Tour's Mayakoba Classic.

The par 5s are where the average golfer will be punished at Playa Paraiso Golf Club. These monsters stretch from the tips to 523, 576, 584, and 526 yards. In case you're wondering, that's just over 32% of the total yardage. While hitting it nice and straight will help you out, if you don't have some giddy up off of the tee, then these holes will instantly become par 7s.

Dye's acclaimed father, Pete, isn't known for giving breaks on par 3s with his golf course designs. That courtesy must have skipped a generation with P.B. because three of the four "short holes" are over 200 yards. Most amateurs will shoot hybrids and fairway woods off of these tees. The 12th hole may even require a driver if it's into the wind, setting up at a healthy 225 yards.

Rated the 7th best course in all of Mexico by Golfweek Magazine, the Iberostar Playa Paraiso Golf Club shows what true rolling fairways and dramatically undulating greens are supposed to look like. After 18 holes you'll want to take a "big break" of your own at the Iberostar Grand Paraiso Hotel. This all-inclusive resort goes above and beyond luxury with four a la carte restaurants and traditional Mayan décor throughout the entire property. The staff and service is second to none, and it will be a repeat destination if you enjoy rest and relaxation.



Spieth Impressive, but Smith Was First

Jordan Spieth's rise to prominence was boosted into orbit when he won the John Deere Classic at TPC Deere Run in July. That set him on a path that earned him a President's Cup berth as a Tour rookie. But Spieth is not the first rookie to crash a team party.

Ever hear of Horton Smith? The Joplin Ghost, sportswriters nicknamed him when he won seven times during his first full year on what was then the winter tour.

This was 1928-29. Smith was 20. as Spieth is now, when he won the Oklahoma City Open and the Catalina Island Open, knocking off Walter Hagen in the latter, before 1928 was out. Smith went on to win five more tournaments, including the fat \$5,000 prize for claiming the La Gorce Open, and the prestigious North and South Open at Pinehurst, before March was out.

Seven wins as a rookie! That prompted the PGA of America to put Smith on the U.S. Ryder Cup team. He won his singles match against Fred Robson at Moortown Golf Club in Leeds, England, though the U.S. lost the overall match, then crossed the English Channel and won the 1929 French Open-on his 21st birthday.

Three years later, Smith took a club job, becoming the head professional at Oak Park Country Club. In 1934, his third year at Oak Park, he won a new event on the circuit: the Augusta National Invitation Tournament. And he won it again two years later.



The 19th hole is usually of equal importance to the golf course itself for any golf experience, and the Tonto Bar and Grill is only a few short steps away and captures the rustic desert ambiance of years gone by with hand-carved beams of the historic ranch ceiling still in place. With two dining areas inside and a covered patio overlooking the 11th green, the facility certainly provides a cozy spot to relax after an enjoyable day on the links.

In addition to offering cold beverages, great care is taken to ensure the menu is second to none and that it fully embraces the local flavors of the southwest. Chef Eric Flatt and his staff also aim to preserve Arizona's heritage through our cuisine





Having opened in 1984, each course is named according to its relationship with the terrain. The courses are at an average elevation of 2,700 feet, in the foothills of the stunning Santa Catalina Mountains. One might argue the best views are found on

the Ridge Course, but play all three and judge for yourself!

Hill Course

The 3,463-yard, par 36 Hill Course starts golfers off with stunning views of the Santa Catalina Mountains and weaves its way through the Saguaro-studded desert landscape. It presents encounters with natural arroyos, saguaro cacti and risk/reward shot decisions. The Hill Course rating/slope information is based off of the 18-hole combination of the Hill and Ridge courses. Signature hole #8 157 yards, par 3. On this short hole, two of the three strokes should be putts. A short iron over a deep valley to a green must be accurate in finding the pin, or the player will have a challenging putt on this moderately contoured green.

Ridge Course

The Ridge Course, at 3,554 yards and par 36, is considered by many to be the most picturesque nine holes available in Southern Arizona. Jack Nicklaus combined the spectacular views with a natural desert landscape design that demands careful shot selection. The Ridge course rating/slope information is based off of the 18-hole combination of the Ridge and Canyon courses.

Signature hole #4 199 yards, par 3. The mountains form a magnificent backdrop for this hole. It plays across the edge of a canyon 30 to 40 feet below the fairway to a well-contained green guarded on the back and left side by grassy hollows and mounds.

Canvon Course

True to its name, this 3,534 yard par 36 layout offers numerous elevated tee shots down to the manicured fairways at the bottom of the desert canyon through which the course has been created. Jack Nicklaus designed a challenging, but fair, experience that rewards well placed shots. The Canyon course rating/slope information is based off of the 18-hole combination of the Ridge and Canyon courses.

Signature hole #7 445 yards, par 4/5. Enjoy the view, but be sure your tee shot is long and to the right on this signature, yet very difficult, hole. A major wash to the left hand and a sloping hill to the right guard the fairway. The approach shot will be a blind one to a green that is cut into a hillside 30 feet higher than the fairway. Instruction

FLY TO THE RAVEN VERRADO

Approaching its 10th Anniversary, the Raven Golf Club at Verrado is among the Best in the Valley, and there's more to come!

If you had to pick just one, hole #13 a short par 4 dead uphill, would be the one. Only 310 yards sounds like a walk in the park, but not here. Hit a middle iron off the tee and

Play to the middle of the green and walk away satisfied with par. Notable fall offs on this green would be the deep bowl on the right side leading to a difficult pitch back onto the green.

At 477 yards, hole #8 is a par 4 with the #1 handicap title attached. This long, demand-

f

error long on your approach shot for the best chance at par. With only two possible pin placements, this tiny green slops back to front on both tiers. Good luck!

Everyone loves a great finishing hole, and this par 4, 495 yard hole just might be the best in Arizona! Playing down hill and downwind this hole provides a great view of the club house. After successfully navigating the fairway bunkers, one is faced with another downhill shot to a well protected green.





If being directly on the beach is more your speed, the Iberostar Cancun is just 30 minutes north and has become one of the premier resorts in Mexico since opening in 2011. Much like the Playa Paraiso, the Iberostar Cancun is an all-inclusive resort that offers a top-notch experience at a great value. With 426 ocean-view rooms, the resort has the largest stretch of beach of any hotel in Cancun in addition to seven pools and five bars. If you're a foodie, you'll enjoy all four restaurants (Gourmet, Japanese, American Steakhouse, and Mexican) in addition to a well-equipped buffet.

Directly across the street from the resort lies the Iberostar Cancun Golf Club. Designed by World Golf Hall of Famer Isao Aoki (Orange County National), this course isn't as difficult as the Playa Paraiso but gives golfers of any level a good test. However, if you happen to play this course on a day that the wind is blowing you could find yourself clubbing up or down on every shot.


Also a par 72, the Iberostar Cancun is 6,734-yards from the tips, 71.1/121. If the course being pressed against the ocean isn't scenic enough, there are remnants of the El Rey Mayan ruins around the course as well.

For being relatively flat, this course offers an array of different hazards. Water comes into play on 10 holes, as does a fair amount of sandy wasteland that varies in depth. Some strategic doglegs can punish longer hitters such as the par 4 6th and the 345yard 15th hole, which is the shortest par 4. Bombing your driver past the safe landing spots spells deep trouble on either.

One of the signature holes at the Iberostar Cancun Golf Club is the 570-yard 16th hole. This par 5 is not only long, but it can hurt you for a long way as bunkers guard the left side of this hole for nearly 250 yards. Not to mention that the front and left sides of the green are guarded by water. If you've got yourself a good round going, this one can end it for sure.

Between the ocean, the palms, and the crocodiles, this course can remind you a lot of golfing in Florida (without the humidity).

The ideal trip for any golf enthusiast would be staying at either the Iberostar Playa Paraiso Resort in Riviera Maya or the Iberostar Cancun and sampling both golf courses. The difference in playability and challenge is vast, but both leave you satisfied and ready for a cerveza or two after your round. All snacks and beverages are included with your green fees after all. *Arriba*!



s the Chicagoland golf season winds **//**down, it is time for golfers to begin preparations for next season. In addition to pounding balls at indoor ranges, let's crack the spines of two books that could help your emotional and spiritual game.

Contrary to popular practice, hurling a lob wedge into a pond is not the only quick fix to combat a skulled shot from a greenside swale. The Successful Golfer is a toolbox for specific mental blocks that affect scorecards and peace of mind. McCarthy and Jones address 50 of the most common faults that can ruin an otherwise pleasant round of golf. Readers will develop strategies to help them deal with a variety of emotions. The authors conducted extensive research that ranged from studies on the yips to the chunks to the shanks. Yes, these ailments have physical symptoms; however, an emotionally ready golfer is rarely reduced to a bad shot becoming a distraction for the entire round, or even an entire season. If you are searching for swing consistency and an emotionally healthy hobby, then The Successful Golfer is just what the swing doctor ordered.

The much-awaited sequel to Golf's Sacred Journey—Seven Days at the Links of Utopia is here. In Johnny's U.S. Open: Golf's Sacred Journey 2, the protagonist returns to Utopia, Texas, for a tune-up for the U.S. Open. Since the original book-which was also made into a motion picture-tens of thousands of people have visited the golf course in Utopia. With increasing traction, Cook's golf titles can be mentioned in the same breath as Golf In The Kingdom.

In Johnny's U.S. Open: Golf's Sacred Journey 2, Cook's readers will learn more about Johnny's background and his family. The sequel also paints Johnny's spiritual teachings with a broader brush that teaches life lessons beyond the golf course. Johnny intrigues us again with his old school methods and the unveiling of a new swing-the Utopia Pre-Set. If you enjoyed Cook's Golf's Sacred Journey-Seven Days at the Links of Utopia, then a return to Utopia, Texas, in Johnny's U.S. Open: Golf's Sacred Journey 2 is a musthave edition on your shelf

Meanwhile, Back at the Ranch

uch more than just a winery, Holman Ranch in Carmel Valley, California, has a long and rich history. Originally, the land was part of a much larger area controlled by the Mission San Carlos Borromeo del Rio Carmelo when the area was still controlled by Mexico.

In 1928, San Francisco businessman Gordon Armsby purchased 600 acres in the Los Laureles area of the Valley, including what would be Holman Ranch. Armsby built a classic Spanish-style hacienda on the property, which served as an exclusive hideaway for many Hollywood celebrities including Charlie Chaplin and Theda Bara.

In the 1940s, financial troubles hit Armsby, forcing him to sell. The new owners transformed it into Holman's Guest Ranch.

Holman Ranch guickly became the center of social life in Carmel Valley. In the tradition of their predecessors, the Holman's had the pleasure of hosting Hollywood's finest: Clark Gable, Vincent Price, Joan Crawford, and Marlon Brando to name a few.

In 1989, Dorothy McEwen stepped in to preserve the Ranch's historic past as a private estate and event facility. She restarted overnight accommodations in guest cottages, founded The Stables, and planted vineyards, although her dream of a winery was never realized.

Thomas and Jarman Lowder purchased Holman Ranch in 2006, and the winery finally became a reality. The Ranch has proven to be quite hospitable for winemaking. The local hills hold back the marine layer and broad breezes, which is beneficial for producing quality fruit. Sedimentary soils throughout the vineyards provide good soil drainage.


After your next round at Pebble Beach, a visit to Holman Ranch is just a twelve-mileinland drive away.

2011 Carmel Valley Chardonnay \$28 This Chard shows pale gold in the glass. The nose is mostly citrus, with hints of honey and acetone.

The citrus really comes through on the palette, with plenty of lemony tartness. Although this wine spent some time in barrel, you'd hardly know it. If you are averse to heavy, buttery Chardonnays, then this is the wine for you. That hint of honey is repeated on the long (for a white) finish. And, don't overchill. Remove it from the refrigerator after just a half-hour or so.

The citrus and acid here would nicely complement Cold Poached Scallops, Sesame Chicken, or Pheasant with Leek and Pecan

Stuffing. 2011 Heather's Hill Pinot Noir \$37 Heather's Hill pours a bright, clear ruby into the glass. The nose suggests dusty boysenberry. There is a light to medium body, typical of Pinot Noir. The taste is all about dark stone fruit (and a little cola), supported by moderate tannins and good acidity. There is some zing to the finish, with hints of tobacco as well. Be sure to air out this wine for an hour, or even two. There's still plenty of nice weather before winter sets in, so enjoy this wine with Pasta Primavera, Raspberry Chicken, or Pork Chops with Black Currant Preserves.

How Low Can You Go

FROM THE FRINGE Insights on the PGA Tour

THE BEST SWINGS IN LIFE ARE

Early in tournament week at the BMW Championship at Conway Farms Golf Club in Lake Forest, magic was on the mind. The number "59" was bandied about by more than one member of the media, especially the locals, as they watched the top 70 players in the FedEx Cup standings get their first look at the Tom Fazio-designed layout in Chicago's north suburbs on some warm, windless days.

"Yeah, that's the only thing they've got," world No. 1 Tiger Woods said of the wind being the course's only defense.

Sure enough, on Thursday Brandt Snedeker shot a 63, highlighted by a run of seven straight birdies. Then, Jim Furyk captured the magic on Friday—carding just the sixth 59 in PGA Tour history—with a bogey on his card.

"It kind of dawned on me at the turn that it would only—'only' is a tough way to say it—but it only takes 4-under on the front, which doesn't seem too far out of reach to kind of break the barrier of 60," Furyk admitted.

While Furyk joked that having only six members of that magical club would suit him, Matt Kuchar came close to making it seven the following day with a 61.

"It crossed my head," he said of the magic number. "I got off to a good start and then had a thought on the last hole, gosh, if I hole this out from the fairway, it's a 59. I think I got it at least to scare the hole a little bit."

Zach Johnson wound up being crowned champion at 16-under, earning his 10th career victory. With only 70 players in the field, the Western Golf Association and PGA Tour were going to get a noteworthy champion. Woods was in contention, as was Winfield native and local hero Kevin Streelman. University of Illinois alumnus and Wisconsin resident Steve Stricker was also in the mix.

The design of the tournament sort of lent itself to that, but unlike the grumbling you heard following the 2011 tournament at Cog Hill, players reacted well to Conway Farms.

"I've been very proud the way Conway Farms has looked on TV, how it's held up," said Conway Farms member and former world No. 1 Luke Donald. "I think there's been a mixture of some really great scores. We saw Jim Furyk's 59, we've seen a lot of high scores from some quality players, as well, and I think that spread is a good indication of a good championship golf course. I've heard a lot of positives from the players, and I think overall it's been a success."

"There's just a few spots you can't hit it, and I'm sure they hit it in those spots; a couple fescue areas and some water hazards," said Streelman, one of only a handful of players that had played the course before tournament week. "There's just a couple holes out there that can really bite you if you hit it in the wrong spot. The same holes you hit them in the right spot you can attack and make birdies. You can see it, when it starts blowing over 20 over here, it gets a little finicky."

Most of the players were complimentary, acknowledging it would be a birdie fest if there was no wind to contend with. Many liked the green complexes, including the new champions, but it wasn't all sunshine and roses.

One player, when asked his impressions, paused for a couple of breaths, and could only offer: "It's well conditioned."

You can't make everyone happy, but assuming the title sponsor extends is partnership, the BMW Championship will return to Conway Farms in 2015. "It's a great test," added Snedeker. "I think it doesn't really favor anybody in the field. It's kind of a wide open kind of golf course where anybody, short hitter, long hitter, great ball striker, poor ball striker can all have a chance, so I think it's a great venue."

Other host options are starting to be put on the table as well. Medinah Country Club had Tom Doak just renovate its No. 1 course and Olympia Fields Country Club has always been an ardent supporter of the WGA. Then there's Cog Hill and Dubsdread. For their part, the WGA hasn't completely ruled a return out.

"It was a part of the Western Golf Association for 20 years, hosting our championship," WGA Vice President of Tournaments Vince Pellegrino said. "They've been a great partner and they've had a wonderful run. We're at Conway Farms this year—what's the future's going hold? We don't know. But we haven't gotten rid of Cog Hill from any future considerations."

Guthrie's Remarkable Season

Jordan Spieth didn't win a major championship, but few players who have had as an incredible a year as the rookie from Texas. He went from having no status on the PGA Tour to a captain's pick for the U.S. Presidents Cup team. An improbable victory at the John Deere Classic in July basically clinched his Rookie of the Year status, but it says a lot that it took that kind of year to overshadow the freshman season of Luke Guthrie.

Guthrie, who earned his 2013 card through the Web.com tour money list, not only made the FedEx Cup playoffs, but advanced to the second round at the Deutsche Bank Championship. He didn't win in the 2013 regular season, but the Quincy native and University of Illinois alumnus recorded two top 10s and six top 25s while earning just under \$1 million. At the conclusion of the BMW Championship, he was the 87th-ranked player in the world.
